Quick tips for multi day visits

- Allow 45mins - 1 hour for each garden visit, and allow a maximum of 6 gardens per day
- Allow 4-5 days for your tour to cover the majority of our gardens.
- Very economical, only \$2pp at each garden, this is payable on entry to each garden. We do not have pre-booked tickets.
- Travel each day to a different geographical location, eg. Waitara/Bell Block, Lepperton/Inglewood/Stratford, Hawera & the surrounding countryside, New Plymouth, Oakura/Okato/Opunake. To plan your route visit taranakigardens.co.nz
- View icons and information on each garden/POI listing to see if toilets, refreshments, plants for sale and wheelchair access are available and whether parking restrictions apply. Dates and open times are also listed.
- Book your accommodation well in advance.

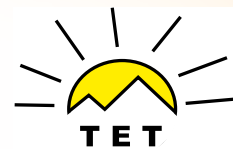
Important for visitors
